

RESIDENTIAL HVAC PROGRAM REBATES

Thank you for your interest in our Energy Optimization rebates for heating and cooling products in your home.

Please carefully review the enclosed information and program details.

• **HVAC savings** - Rebates are available to Great Lakes Energy residential members who replace existing equipment (new construction not included).

• **Do I qualify?** Rebates are available to cooperative members only. Multiple rebates are allowed per account (meter) when multiple pieces of equipment are installed on or after 3/15/10. All equipment must be installed at the account location to receive the rebate.

• **What are the rebate amounts?**

- \$100 when you replace your existing furnace blower motor with an ECM (Electronically Commutated Motor) blower motor.
- \$100 when you install a new furnace with an ECM (Electronically Commutated Motor) blower motor.
- \$100 when you replace your existing air conditioner with a new unit with a SEER or 15 or higher.
- \$50 rebate for replacing an electric water heater with a new electric water heater rated with a .93 efficiency factor (EF) or higher.
- \$4 for each 5 ft. piece of pipe wrap installed on your electric water heater outlet pipe.
- \$20 for replacing your standard thermostat with a programmable thermostat.

• **Where do I purchase the equipment?** You can purchase the equipment from any contractor or local retail outlet. Marathon water heaters are available directly from GLE contractors in our service area. Other brands of electric water heaters are eligible, but not available from GLE.

• **Who installs the equipment?** All equipment, except for the water heater, must be installed and verified by a third-party contractor. Water heaters can be installed and verified by the homeowner. You are responsible for installation labor and related charges. See the enclosed "Terms and Conditions" for complete information.

• **When will I receive my rebate and how?** Rebates will be issued in the form of bill credits on your GLE electric account **after** equipment installation is complete at the account location and completed application form with required documentation is received by Great Lakes Energy within 30 days of installation. Rebates will be processed within 6-8 weeks of receipt of complete information.

• **Can I receive more than one rebate?** Yes, you can receive a rebate for each piece of equipment installed.

• **Can I still receive a rebate for my Marathon electric water heater purchase?** Yes, Marathon rebates are a separate GLE program. Please contact us for information.

• **What information do you need from me?** A completed and signed rebate form must be returned with copies of the purchase receipt and installation receipt (if applicable) for each item being considered for a rebate. Incomplete forms will be returned.

• **How long are the rebates available?** The program is subject to change and cancellation at any time.

The Electric Utility will not be responsible for lost documentation pertaining to this application request. Details of this program, including incentive levels, are subject to change or cancellation without prior notice. This application with required documentation must be received within 30 days of the installation's completion. Please visit Michigan-energy.org for the most up-to-date details.

LIMITED FUNDS: Funds for incentives are limited and available on a first-come, first-served basis. Incentive amounts are valid through Dec. 31, 2010. The Electric Utility reserves the right to not pay this incentive if funds are not available at the time of application approval, or if the form and all required additional information are not filled out completely and accurately.

ELIGIBILITY: This offer is valid for the Michigan Electric Utility residential members/customers applying through the Electric Utility Residential HVAC Program only. Members/customers applying for a rebate must receive electricity distribution service from the Electric Utility. This offer is not valid for new construction homes or commercial properties. Equipment must be installed in the Electric Utility service territory. Eligible systems are listed above in section V of the application.

APPROVAL, VERIFICATION AND INSPECTION: Prior to any payment of incentives, the Electric Utility reserves the right to verify sales transactions. Contractor will verify that the installed energy saving measures meet all applicable building codes, zoning laws, local, state, and federal requirements, and other relevant requirements. Contractor is responsible for any applicable permits as required by aforementioned code/law. Outdoor temperatures may affect this verification process. Member's/customer's home may also be selected for a quality control post-installation inspection by the Electric Utility. No warranty is implied by this inspection.

PROOF OF PURCHASE: A contractor's invoice itemizing the purchased equipment must accompany each Electric Utility HVAC Rebate Application Form. The invoice copy must indicate the equipment type, make, model, price, serial numbers and the date of purchase.

PAYMENT: Please allow up to 6-8 weeks for payment. Payment processing may take longer if information is missing on the application. Please contact your local Electric Utility if you have any questions about your incentive.

TAX LIABILITY: The Electric Utility will not be responsible for any tax liability that may be imposed on the member/customer as a result of the payment of incentives. Please contact your tax advisor for more information.
